**HOLDING OF 16<sup>TH</sup> PHILIPPINE CHEMISTRY CONGRESS**

1 The Philippine Federation of Chemistry Societies will hold its 16<sup>th</sup> Philippine Chemistry Congress at the Manila Hotel Rizal Park, Manila on May 27-29, 2000 with the theme 'Chemistry for the New Millennium'

2 The 16<sup>th</sup> Philippine Chemistry Congress will cover all aspects of Chemistry Analytical Chemistry, Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Chemical Education, Computational Chemistry, Environmental Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Natural Products and Organic Chemistry Polymer Chemistry and Materials Science

3 Chemists from the academe government and industry are invited to present technical papers for oral and poster sessions. The paper may be an original research work a review of recent developments in Chemistry and allied fields or on Chemical Education. Interested parties are requested to submit an abstract consisting of 150 to 200 words by March 3, 2000 to the Committee on Scientific Sessions, 16<sup>th</sup> Philippine Chemistry Congress, c/o Dr Myrna S Rodriguez, UP Open University, Los Baños, Laguna. Papers may also be e-mailed to [mj@chem.uplb.edu.ph](mailto:mj@chem.uplb.edu.ph). All submitted papers should indicate the name address telephone fax, and/or e-mail address of presenter and the preferred mode of presentation (oral or poster). The presenter will be notified of acceptance by the middle of March. All presenters must be registered with the Congress.

4 Participants should be enrolled full time. Full attendance at the 16<sup>th</sup> Philippine Chemistry Congress entitles the participant to 20 Continuing Professional Education (CPE) units.
