CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 The contest is open to all elementary school students from Grades 4 to 6 nationwide. The major objective of the contest is to promote better hearing and objected noise-induced hearing loss.
- Entries must be done on drawing paper or white cartolina measuring 18 x 20 resed vertically. Water color, crayon poster paint craypas, pentel pen colored pentel, etc. or any combination of several media may be used. ENTRIES MUST Bt. PROFLCTED BY A CLEAR PLASTIC COVER.
- Entries must depict the theme Controlling Noise Is In Your Hand'
- Participants must indicate the name, address age school and a short description about the drawing at the back of the poster ONE ENTRY ONLY per pre-tricipant
- Board of Judges in the Division Level shall be appointed by the Schools Division Superintendent while the Regional Director shall appoint the Judges in the Regional Level Entries shall be judged based on the following criteria
