2000 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

To Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Chairman, CHED

1 The Bureaus of Elementary and Secondary Education in coordination with non government agencies are sponsoring training programs in Special Education in Summer 2000 at the following institutions

- a Philippine Normal University Taft Avenue Manila "Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired April 24 to May 19, 2000
- b Cebu State University, Cebu City - "Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired , April 3 to April 28, 2000, and
- c Eulogio "Amang" Rodriguez, Institute of Science and Technology (EARIST) Sta Mesa, Manila "Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired", April 25 to May 23 2000

2 The training programs for the teachers of the visually impaired will be funded by the Resources for the Blind Inc (RBI), 623 EDSA, Quezon City while the training program for the hearing impaired will be funded by Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM), Alabang Muntinlupa City

3 These programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to visually or hearing impaired children

4 Priority participants/nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/ schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the visually impaired (See Enclosures Nos I A & B) The training for the new batch of teachers for the hearing impaired has been deferred due to budgetary constraints Applicants shall be screened by the Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on

the criteria set in Enclosure No 2 Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is on the 3rd week of February 2000 Selected applicants for the visually impaired should make a collect call to Mr Randy Weisser, Resources for the Blind Inc, tel no 726-30-21 for the interview before March 2000 The list of nominees shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division Bureau of Elementary Education not later than March 15, 2000 The selected nominee shall be advised to submit all the documents listed in Enclosures Nos 2 and 3 to the same office before the summer session

5 Selected teachers who were recipients of the DECS-RBI-PNU Summer Training Programs in 1998 and 1999 and DECS-CBM-EARIST Summer Training in 1999 are listed in Enclosures No 4 A, B, and C Only those teachers who are actually providing educational services to the visually or hearing impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue their training in Summer 2000

6 Grantees under the two training programs outside NCR shall be entitled to free tuition fee and a monthly stipend of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000 00) Their travelling expenses to and from Manila shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies They are advised to travel by sea or land Trainees from NCR are entitled to free tuition fee and a monthly stipend of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000 00)

7 State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education DECS Complex, Meralco Avenue Pasig City with the required documents Expenses for the training shall be charged to their agency funds Teachers who will be joining the training for the visually impaired shall pay their tuition fees to the Resources for the Blind, Inc, c/o Mr Randy Weisser

- 4 Is not more than 45 years
- 5 If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother
- 6 Has no administrative/criminal record
- 7 Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students
- 8 Is willing to conduct and/or assist in in-service training activities after scholarship
- 9 Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses
- 10 Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years
- 11 Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino
