CONFERENCE OF THE ASSOCIATION OF ENGLISH RESEARCHERS  
AND TEACHERS IN THE PHILIPPINES (ASSERT-PHILS )

To Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1 The Association of English Researchers and Teachers in the Philippines (ASSERT Phils) will conduct a seminar-workshop on the theme "English Language Teaching in the New Millennium Charting Our Course" on April 27-29, 2000 at the Midtown Hotel Cebu City

2 The main purpose of the conference is to discuss key issues in English language education curriculum and teacher development and the use of information technology in language teaching

3 Expected to attend are language teachers at the basic and higher education levels, English language supervisors, other language educators and enthusiasts. Participants from the public schools are allowed to attend on official time only. Those from the private sector shall make arrangements with their respective schools/institutions.

4 Pre-registration fee is Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P2,250.00) and on-site registration is Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00). Members of the association will pay Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00). The fee entitles the participants to meals (lunch and snacks for the duration of the seminar), materials and certificates of attendance.

5 Prof. David Nunan, language specialist and President of TESOL International will be the keynote speaker. Dr. Michael Jenson and George Scholtz, the American Regional English Language Officers assigned in Southeast Asia and Filipino language specialists will be the speakers in the plenary sessions and workshops.
