FOUR SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS FOR ELEMENTARY  
AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

To Bureau Directors

1 In line with the department's continuing program to develop and enhance instructional expertise and capabilities at the school level through subject specific specialization without distracting regular conduct of classes, the Department of Education Culture and Sports through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Staff Development Division-HRDS, announces the launching of the following four summer special scholarship programs for elementary and secondary classroom teachers

2 For Summer 2000, the following special scholarship courses are being offered

MA in Education Philippine Normal University  
Major in Filipino Teaching Taft Avenue Manila  
(For Secondary School Teachers)

MA in Education Philippine Normal University  
Major in English Teaching Taft Avenue Manila  
(For Elementary School Teachers)

MA in Education Philippine Normal University  
Major in Teaching Reading Taft Avenue, Manila  
(For Elementary School Teachers)

MA in Education University of the Philippines  
Major in Social Studies Diliman Quezon City  
(For Elementary School Teachers)

3 The scholarship programs are four summers (Summer 2000 2001 2002 and 2003), for non thesis courses specially customized to DECS elementary and secondary school teachers. The courses are scheduled to start on April 2000 and end on May 2003

4 The Identified subject areas will accommodate 40 scholars each Based on teacher population the following scheme will be observed in the distribution of regional slots for both elementary and secondary schools teachers

5 Following the criteria for the selection of candidates provided in the enclosure division nominees shall be initially selected by the Regional Scholarship Screening Committee The regional nominees will undergo the final examinations and interview to be administered and conducted by a team from NEAP, SDD HRDS on the dates and venues specified below

The deadline for submission of the official list of regional nominees is one week before the abovementioned final examinations and interview To ensure that all regional slots are filled up, the regions are advised to nominate for the final selection, more alternate candidates

6 The scholarship recipients are entitled to the following assistance

- 1) free tuition and other school fees
- 2) full salary during the scholarship period
- 3) stipend of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3 500 00) per month of every summer
- 4) book allowance of Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P750 00) per summer and
- 5) research allowance of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500 00)

**CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF NOMINEES FOR THE FOUR-SUMMER  
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS FOR ELEMENTARY AND  
SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS**

- 1 A bachelors degree holder of a course related to the area of scholarship being nominated for or a major/minor of the subject specified in the offering
- 2 Must have a grade point average of not lower than 2 B or 85 in the undergraduate level,
- 3 Holds a permanent employment status with at least three (3) years teaching experience and with Very Satisfactory (VS) performance
- 4 Is actually teaching the subject or course being nominated for
- 5 Not more than 50 years of age,
- 6 Has no pending administrative and/or criminal case
- 7 Has been certified by a government physician to be medically fit,
- 8 Has not availed of a scholarship program in the last two (2) years,
- 9 Is proficient in both written and oral communication
- 10 Has experience in writing/developing instructional materials in the subject area and
- 11 Has demonstrated skills in conducting training programs


**PERTINENT PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED TO DECS-CO SCHOLARSHIP  
COMMITTEE**

- 1 Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) duly certified by the Administrative Officer
- 2 Photocopy of Transcript of Records duly certified by the Administrative Officer
- 3 Form 86(Health Certificate)
- 4 Service Record
- 5 Certification from principal/school head on nominees' performance rating relevant to actual teaching/supervision of the subject and recommending him for scholarship
- 6 Endorsement by the superintendent
- 7 Duly accomplished Scholarship Contract
- 8 4-copies of 2x2 colored picture

7 Travel expenses of scholars to and from the venue every summer shall be charged against regional/local INSET funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Other non DECS funds may also be sourced out by the grantees to defray travel cost.

8 Principals and school administrators of the grantees are advised to reorganize their school programs accordingly to accommodate the classes and subject loads which will be affected by the absence of the teachers.

9 Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
