NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

- To Bureau Directors
 Regional Directors
 Schools Division/City Superintendents
- In pursuance to the provision contained in R.A. 7079 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991 which mandates the Department of Education, Culture and Sports to provide training programs/seminars for student editors/writers and tracher advisers. The National Training Program for School Paper Advisers for SY 2000-2001 shall be held at the Teachers Camp. Baguio City on April 26. 28. 2000.
- The theme of this year's training program is "Campus Journalism Facing the Challenges of the New Millennium
- 3 The participants to this training program are

- 4 The training program aims to
 - update the school paper advisers on trends in school paper management and prepare them in tackling the challenges of the new millennium
 - equip school paper advisers with the necessary skills for school paper production using the latest trends towards a more efficient implementation of the journalism program
 - provide a forum for a healthy sharing and exchange of ideas, experiences, strategies and plans for a better school paper management program and
 - further enhance the teaching competencies and journalistic skills of elementary school paper advisers in layouting, feature writing editorial writing and sports newswriting

- The first meal to be served will be breakfast on April 26 while the last meal will be dinner of April 28 However participants shall be accommodated starting afternoon of April 25 until afternoon of April 28
- Transportation and other travel expenses of participants relative to this training program shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, the same expenses of the members of the Executive Committee national coordinators trainors speakers, chairpersons and members of the working committees from Manila to Baguio City and back to Manila as well as board and lodging for all participants, workshop materials and honoraria shall be charged against journalism funds as provided for in R.A. 7079 also subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
- The guidelines to be considered in the choice of the participants the composition of the Executive and Working Committees the elected officers of the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (NSSPAA) and the Philippine Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (PAESPA) are in Appendix "A" of this Memorandum
- The 16 Presidents of the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers are expected to submit to the BSE representative a definite schedule and venue of the regional training program for SY 2000-2001 in their respective regions. These data shall be appended to the DECS Memorandum announcing the Regional Training Program for School Paper Advisers to be issued immediately after the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers.

GUIDELINES ON THE CHOICE OF PARTICIPANTS TO THE NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS - SY 2000 2001

- 1 The total number of participants for the training program shall not be more than six hundred forty four (644)
- 2 The Regional School Paper Advisers' Associations (elem & sec) in coordination with the Schools Division Superintendent shall select 4 advisers, 2 elementary and 2 secondary level participants
- For the hands on training on desktop publishing, there shall be two participants per division
 - + one who has never undergone any computer training, and
 - another who is computer literate but needs training on the Pagemaker Program
- 4 The list of participants shall be submitted to the DECSRO for approval on or before March 15, 2000 Subsequently, the approved list shall be submitted to the Bureau of Secondary Education, attn Mr Angelito O Pineda, DECS Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City not later than March 31, 2000
