NATIONAL MASCOT NAME ME CONTEST 2000 FOR THE NEE ACCREDITATION AND EQUIVALENCY SYSTEM

- To **Bureau and Center Directors** Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents
- The Nonformal Education Accreditation and Equivalency (NFE A&E) System is a national program of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports Bureau of Nonformal Education (DECS-BNFE) funded under the ADB assisted Philippines Nonformal Education Project (PNFEP) It is envisioned to provide an alternative means of certification of learning to those Filipinos who have dropped out of formal elementary and secondary education
- The Nonformal Education Accreditation and Equivalency System aims to 2
 - provide a system for assessing levels of literacy and nonformal learning achievements based on a national NFE A&E curriculum covering basic and functional education skills and competencies and designed to be comparable to the formal school system,
 - offer an alternative pathway by which out-of school youth and adults earn an educational qualification comparable to the formal elementary and secondary school system, and
 - enable out-of school youth and adults to gain reading writing and numeracy skills, to meet their learning goals as they define them and to gain the skills they need to improve their economic status and function more effectively in society
- To effectively and efficiently achieve the above objectives of the NFE A&E Learning Support Delivery System, varied Advocacy and Social Mobilization activities/strategies are recommended to raise consciousness regarding the NFE A&E System
- Anent to this, the BNFE is conducting a Mascot Name Me contest on the NFL A&E System The objective of the contest is to arouse the interest of the learners presently enrolled and those who have been enrolled in the Learning Support Delivery System (LSDS) sessions for a deeper involvement and a sense of belonging to the NFE A&E System
- The proclamation of the national winner will be held on May 19, 2000 at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan DECS Complex Meralco Avenue, Pasig City
- This national Mascot naming contest is open to all enrollees/learners of the NFE Accreditation and Equivalency System who are 15 years old and above. They should come from provinces and cities involved in the NFE A&E namely Regions IV V VI VII, VIII IX NCR CAR and ARMM as specified in Enclosure No 2 of this Memorandum

The NFL A&E Logo

1 Rationale

.

A logo with Mascot which appears on the top right corner has been designated to symbolize the NFE A&E Alternative Education System for Out-of-School Youth and Adults 15 years old and above. The figure of Mascot depicted in the Logo is to be given a name by the NFE A&E learners willing to participate in the contest. The contest is devised to help develop in the learners a sense of belonging within the A&E System.

- 2 The various design components of the Logo symbolizes the NFE A&E System
 - Steps represent the learning levels within the BNFE Programs and NFE A&E System i.e. Basic Literacy Elementary and Secondary Levels
 - A&E Initials stand for the System's name Accreditation (of Service Providers) and Equivalency (of Learner's Level of Certification)
 - Red Border represents the boundaries of learning set by the NFE A&E Curriculum Framework
 - Open Corner top right symbolizes the unlimited opportunities awaiting NFE A&F secondary level certificate holders e.g. access to Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) training programs eventual access to Commission on Higher Education (CHED) approved courses and employment opportunities recognized by the Civil Service Commission (CSC)
 - The blue NFE A&E Figure or Mascot -- represents the NFE A&E learner and has the following
 - Androgynous (neither male or female)
 - Ageless (neither young nor old)
 - Self-propelled (neither pushed nor pulled nor forced into through or out of the program)
 - · The Mascot's apparent movement and design has meaning as well
 - Appears in flight reflecting the NFE A&E flexible learning philosophy, e.g. the learner may progress through the system at his/her own pace
 - The deliberate omission of feet and hands indicating that NFE A&E differs from formal education in that the learner may
 - ⇒ Enroll at any level for which he/she is suited.
 - ⇒ Choose any of the learning modules at his/her own pace
 - ⇒ Progress through the modules at his/her own pace
 - ⇒ Exit the System at will
 - > The colors of the A&E Logo are also symbolic
 - ⇒ The letters and steps in the inner parameters are yellow symbolizing Enlightenment and Vitality
 - The border is Red symbolizing "A Passion for Learning
 - ⇒ The color scheme of the whole design Red, White, Blue and Yellow -represent the Philippine Flag - the NFE A&E System's country of origin
