**NATIONAL TRAINORS TRAINING ON PRACTICAL GEOGRAPHY

1 The Department of Education Culture and Sports through the Bureau of Secondary Education will conduct a National Trainors Training on Practical Geography for the Secondary Level on April 26-28, 2000 at the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) Teachers Camp, Baguio City

2 The training aims to

- a enhance the competency of trainors on the teaching of Geography in the secondary schools
- b assist principals in the effective translation of curriculum competencies to classroom practices, and
- c develop awareness of the value of charts graphs tables maps and other multi-media resources in organizing and using information

3 Participants in this training are the following one (1) Education Supervisor II (Social Studies) one (1) Education Supervisor I (Social Studies) and one (1) Social Studies teacher major in Social Studies/History per region Teacher participants should possess strong leadership potential, they must be 45 years old and below and have at least 5 years teaching experience
