DECS MEMORANDUM

2ND NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR CAMPUS JOURNALISTS
(Secondary Level – SY 2000-2001)

To Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1 Pursuant to the provision contained in R.A. 7079 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991 which mandates the Department of Education, Culture and Sports to conduct periodic seminars/training programs for campus journalists and school paper advisers the 2nd National Training Program for Campus Journalists shall be held on May 23-25 2000 at the Teachers Camp Baguio City

2 Participants shall be accommodated starting afternoon of May 22 however the first meal to be served will be breakfast on May 23, and the last meal will be dinner of May 25

3 The training program is sponsored and partly subsidized from the Campus Journalism Fund by the Department of Education Culture and Sports in coordination with the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association and the National Secondary Editors Guild

4 The theme for this year's training program is "Challenges of the New Millennium to Campus Journalism"

5 The participants in the training program are

- a Incoming Junior Editors (1 English and 1 Filipino editor from each division to be chosen by the division supervisor in-charge of Journalism in coordination with the Regional Secondary School Paper Advisers Association provided that in the total number of regional participants the regional president shall be included as one of the two participants of the division where the regional president comes from),
- b Officers of the National Secondary Editors Guild
- c One secondary regional supervisor in-charge of Journalism
- d 12 core trainers from the different regions and
- e Working committee members composed of officers of the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association and staff of the Bureau of Secondary Education

6 The list of participants from each division shall be submitted to the Regional Office on or before March 31 2000 On the other hand the list of regional participants (Identifying the Regional President of the Editors Guild) shall be submitted to BSE, Attention Mr Angellito O Pineda on or before May 8, 2000


7 The training program generally aims to develop the students skills on three major categories namely editorial writing copyreading and headline writing, and sportswriting. At the end of the 3-day training program the participants shall have developed the following specific skills

- ◆ Editorial Writing
 - a critical thinking and sound reasoning and
 - b presenting arguments in logical sequence
- ◆ Copyreading and Headline Writing
 - a integrating grammar lessons in editing manuscripts to achieve brevity and
 - b correcting errors in grammars facts, structure, and style
- ◆ Sportswriting
 - a reporting sports events accurately and
 - b using correct and colorful sports language

8 Each student-participant shall pay a minimum registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) while each regional supervisor participant shall pay One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P1 800.00) to cover board and lodging to be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. On the other hand travelling expenses and honoraria for the trainers and members of the executive and working committees relative to their attendance and participation in the training program shall be charged against OSEC Journalism Funds (R.A. 7079)

9 The composition of the Executive and Working Committees is in Enclosure No. 1 while the list of officers of the National Editors Guild 2000 as well as the Board of Directors is in Enclosure No. 2

10 Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired
