**KAGUNARI SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON THE TEACHING OF RIZAL COURSE**

To Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

1 The Kapisanan ng mga Guro ng Nagmamahal Kay Rizal (KAGUNARI) in cooperation with the DECS and CHED will sponsor a Seminar-Workshop on the Teaching of Rizal Course at the Philippine Normal University (PNU) on May 2-4 2000 with the theme "Rizal for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century". This activity is a response to the need to professionalize the teaching of mandated Rizal course in all levels as a means of sustaining the nationalistic spirit engendered by last year's celebration of the centennial of Philippine Independence.

2 The objectives of the seminar are to

- a upgrade and professionalize the teaching of the Rizal subject in compliance with the objective of R A 1425
- b assess and evaluate the teaching of the Rizal subject in terms of content and pedagogy,
- c define the objective and the scope of the subject in the context of the present situation in the Philippines as it moves towards the next millennium
- d train participants on approaches that will enable them to handle the subject as historically accurate and gender fair as possible,
- e produce a model outline-syllabus and a comprehensive reading list of background materials and
- f introduce participants to the effective and creative strategies of teaching the Rizal subject.

3 Participants are Social Studies/History teachers in the secondary level. A registration fee of One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P1 200 00) will be charged each participant to cover seminar bag & kit lunch & snacks and certificate of participation. Delegates from the public schools are allowed to attend on official time only. They may use funds from the Local School Board or from other private sources not DECS funds.
