**WORKSHOP ON THE DECENTRALIZATION OF THE CURRICULUM**

1 A Workshop on the Decentralization of the Curriculum will be held on April 17 18 2000 at SEAMEO-INNOTECH Commonwealth Avenue Quezon City The workshop is one of the activities of the Technical Assistance (TA) on Decentralization a study of the Department of Education Culture and Sports (DECS) funded by the Asian Development Bank (ADB)

2 The aim of the workshop is to formulate policy recommendations on curriculum decentralization based on the following activities

- a Identification of aspects of the curriculum to be decentralized
- b defining approaches and strategies in the decentralization of curriculum development, implementation and evaluation, and
- c recommending actors and appropriate actions to implement curriculum decentralization

3 The 2-day workshop will provide the participants with a) an overview of the proposals of the TA on a decentralized management for DECS b) inputs on current status and policies on curriculum development and implementation in basic education and c) a venue of sharing and exchange of ideas on curriculum decentralization The Workshop Program is in Enclosure No 1

4 The participants to the workshop are officials of the DECS central regional and division offices school administrators and teachers from selected public and private elementary and high schools representatives from selected professional organizations and the TA consultants The list of participants is shown in Enclosure No 2

5 Cost of board lodging and workshop materials of the participants will be borne by the TA Travel to and from venue of participants from the DECS central regional and division offices shall be charged against their respective local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations Round trip travelling expenses of school principals teachers and private sector participants will be reimbursed out of the TA fund upon presentation of plane ticket and boarding passes or other proof of receipts for overland transportation
