SUBJECT 2ND NATIONAL ROVER MOOT

- 1 We are please to announce the holding of the 2nd National Rover Moot at Barangay Sta Ana Calatagan Batangas on June 11-14, 2000 simultaneously with the 11th World Scout Rover Moot at Mexico. The theme of this year's Rover Moot is "Tradition for Tomorrow" which is also the theme of the World Rover Moot.
- 2 The objectives of the Moot are:
 - a Organize activities that will promote the moral and spiritual upliftment of the Rover Scouts
 - b Provide activities that will accomplish some of the advancement requirements of the Rover Scouting Program
 - c Participate in environmental development projects sponsored by the Community/Barangay agencies
- 3 A minimum of 4,000 Rover Scouts is targeted for this gathering. Hereunder is the minimum quota of each region:

a Ilocos Region	40	f Bicol Region	1036
b Central Luzon Region	72	g Western Visayas	247
c Northeastern Luzon	76	h Eastern Visayas	869
d National Capital Region	226	i Western Mindanao	93
e Southern Tagalog	1072	j Eastern Mindanao	275
- 4 A registration fee of **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 500.00)** shall be charged each participant to cover the cost of souvenir items, program materials and other operating expenses.
- 5 All Local Councils shall form their respective Rover Moot committees to attend to the promotion of this activity. All contingents are expected to meet their own:
 - a) Moot funding requirements
 - b) camping gears
 - c) transportation requirements to and from the Moot site
 - d) sufficient food supply to last for the duration of the event
- 6 For strict compliance.
