- 1 The Atlas Publishing Company the publisher of MOD and other quality publications recently launched a Reading Awareness Campaign to encourage the youth to read more instead of getting involved in drugs
- This is in response to the alarming report of the Philippine National Police Narcotics Group that drug addiction has been responsible for the worsening of the crime situation by 50% affecting about one-third of the country's population mostly persons in the 20 s age bracket
- The Company launched the campaign by publishing various reading slogans in all its magazines comics and other publications encouraging the youth to develop the habit of reading as an alternative to drug abuse. Copies of the slogans have also been sent to newspaper magazine and book publishers for them to participate in the said campaign.
