Please be reminded that the payment of monthly premium contributions for public and private sector employers is on or before the 10th of the month following the applicable month through PhilHealth Accredited Collecting Banks (ACBs) nearest you

Note however that the current premium contributions of the programs individually Paying Members (including all existing self-employed members of the SSS) is fixed at P75 00 per month and shall be paid quarterly semi annually or annually Overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) enrolled with the NHIP shall pay an annual contribution of P1 500 00 if paid in the Philippines or US\$ 40 00 if paid overseas. These premium rates shall remain until further notice
