**IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTENSIVE SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS  
TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM (ISMATTP) OF PROJECT RISE**

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) announces the implementation of the Intensive Science and Mathematics Teacher Training Program (ISMATTP) of Project RISE for the Year 2000.
2. This is a 180-hour training program to be conducted within the months of April and May 2000.
3. The project aims to improve/enhance the capabilities of the science and mathematics teachers in both the elementary and secondary levels to empower them to teach more effectively and efficiently.
4. Participants are Grade 3 Science and Mathematics teachers in the elementary level and General Science and Mathematics I teachers in the secondary level of identified schools in each region. Priority shall be given to teachers who are non-majors but are teaching the subjects.
5. Participants will be provided free training fee, stipend of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) for the duration of the training, book/teaching aid allowance of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) and the actual transportation allowance (only once) in going to the training venue and back.
6. Travel expenses, stipend, book allowance and training fee of the participants shall be borne by the Science Education Institute-Department of Science and Technology (SEI-DOST).

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7 The training program shall be conducted in 26 selected training centers nationwide. A Regional Technical Committee (RTC) chaired by the DOST Regional Director shall provide all the details about the training program in coordination with the members of the RTC from DECS, CHED, RSTC, TESDA, and selected teacher training institutions.

8 Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
