**NATIONAL TRAINING ON THE HUMAN EVOCATIVE APPROACH
TO TEACHING/TRAINING (HEAT)**

1 The Visions and Breakthroughs International Inc (VBI) in coordination with the Department of Education Culture and Sports (DECS) will conduct the Human Evocative Approach to Teaching/Training (HEAT) a transformational training for educators HR and training professionals in four separate workshop sessions set within the year as follows:

- d Create a venue where educators can collaborate and benchmark with corporate HR and training practitioners on best people development practices and
- e Brainstorm and exchange ideas on how educators can lay a stronger learning foundation for students to eventually become globally competitive individuals in their chosen field of endeavor

3 The workshops will be facilitated by a team of international learning and education consultants and certified professional coaches led by Mr Julius C Ordoñez the developer of HEAT

4 Expected participants are representative superintendents supervisors principals master teachers and subject coordinators from each region to be determined by the regional director and the superintendents Only a maximum of 50 participants per session can be accommodated on a first come first served basis due to the nature of the training program The regions/divisions may communicate their exact number of participants to the
