THE YOUNG WEB DESIGNERS AWARDS

To Bureau Directors

1 The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in coordination with the Department of Education Culture and Sports is conducting The Young Web Designers Awards as part of the National Science and Technology Week (NSTW) Celebration 2000

2 The project is aimed at enhancing the interests of the youth in information and communication technology (ICT) thereby encouraging them to pursue careers relevant to the demands of the future industries and at training them in web design and harnessing their skills in S&T undertakings


3 The contest is open to Filipino high school students individuals or groups from any year level who are able to create their own homepage The guidelines of the contest is enclosed

4 The contest will be conducted in two (2) phases the elimination phase which requires all participants to submit their homepage online through www.sei.dost.gov.ph or through e mail seidost@info.com.ph on or before June 12 2000 and the national finals an onstage competition to be conducted in Metro Manila with 20 national finalists undergoing a training in the use of the prescribed software prior to the contest proper on June 29 2000

5 The national finalists or their alternates who will be coming from the regions shall be provided transportation and accommodation by the organizers and sponsors Each regional participant is entitled to be accompanied by one (1) adult chaperone whose transportation and accommodation expenses shall likewise be borne by the organizers/sponsors National finalists coming from Metro Manila will be provided meals during the training and the contest proper

6 The national winners will be awarded with the following cash prizes First prize – P50 000 00 Second prize – P30 000 00 and Third prize – P20 000 00 Each of the non winning seventeen (17) finalists will be given P5 000 00 consolation prize Additional prizes will be provided by the sponsors of the contest All concerned are hereby enjoined to encourage interested students to join in the said contest

THE YOUNG WEB DESIGNERS AWARDS

Who are qualified to compete for the Awards?

- 1 Filipino high school students individual or teams who can design a homepage using any software
- 2 Team participants may come from the same or different schools and may belong to the same or different year levels

How to join

- 1 For individual entries submit a homepage on the topic "All About Me and What I Want to Be" or for team entries "All About Us and What We Want to Be" online through www.seidost.gov.ph or e-mail at seidost@info.com.ph on or before June 12, 2000
- 2 Submit entries with the accomplished registration sheet available at the same website and e-mail address

Mechanics of the Contest

- 1 The Board of Judges who will have their own passwords shall access and screen online all coded entries
- 2 Twenty (20) national finalists will be chosen from among the entries submitted
- 3 The organizers will officially notify the national finalists through e-mail and fax or mail
- 4 The national finalists will have to undergo a one-day training for the software to be used in the national finals
- 5 The national finals will be on the-spot webpage design using a prescribed software and a library of resources to be provided by the organizers
- 6 The theme for the national finals shall be made known to the participants on the day of the actual competition
- 7 For team entries qualifying to the national finals only one principal representative will be allowed to join the final competition. However, an alternate may be allowed as substitute in case of emergencies
- 8 National finalists coming from the regions will be provided with round trip fare and accommodation. The organizers will sponsor only one (1) principal representative or alternate and one (1) chaperone for team finalists coming from the regions. National finalists from Metro Manila will be provided meals during the training and the national final competition.

- 9 The Board of Judges shall be present during the final onstage competition
- 10 The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and unappealable
- 11 Once the participants submit their entries the organizers shall be allowed to display the same in the specified website for evaluation of the judges on a limited access. The winners shall also authorize the organizers to publicly exhibit the winning entries during the DOST S&T Fair and other regional exhibitions
