**DECS BATTLECRY AGAINST POVERTY

To Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1 In line with the National Government's programs and projects on food security the Department of Education Culture and Sports (DECS) has made a commitment now and beyond to harness education as a tool not only to raise more food for better health and nutrition but also as a tool to fight poverty for the nation's economic recovery Thus the project Pagkaing Sapat Para sa Lahat' is conceived the DECS Battlecry to Fight Poverty

2 **PAGKAIN** means **FOOD** and likewise the acronym for **Pagsasakatuparan ng Adhikang Gabayan ang Kaunlaran/Kasaganaan sa Ating INang Bayan** Pagkaing Sapat Para sa Lahat' call for the highest degree of involvement and commitment of our educational community to attain the nation's progress through food production

3 In this connection DECS will undertake the following initial activities

- 3.1 Poster Making Contest to raise pupils and students awareness and to allow them to express their ideas/concept about this project Pagkaing Sapat Para sa Lahat' with the slogan

**Magkaisa tayong sama samang gumawa upang
ating kamtan buhay na masagana**

The winning entry will be the official poster of DECS to this project for advocacy to be displayed in the schools all over the 16 regions of the Philippines (Enclosure No 1) It shall also be reproduced in T shirts for the implementors Announcement of winners and awarding of prizes will be held during the launching of Pagkaing Sapat Para sa Lahat' in Luzon Cluster 1 on July 7 2000 (Enclosure No 2)

- 3.2 Four (4) day seminar workshop to be conducted in the three (3) regional clusters that will focus on varied innovative technologies in the following food production activities (Enclosure No 2)

- 3.2.1 Vegetable Gardening Nursery and Plant Propagation Fruit and Crop Production
3.2.2 Fish Culture
3.2.3 Poultry Raising
3.2.4 Livestock and Swine Production

- 4 The 'Pagkaing Sapat Para sa Lahat' seminar workshop aims to
- 4.1 Revitalize/intensify school based food production through the use of varied technologies
 - 4.2 Rekindle the love for gardening and other work related to food production
 - 4.3 Develop skills in entrepreneurship and project management
 - 4.4 Strengthen integrity teamwork sense of responsibility among implementors and
 - 4.5 Reduce malnutrition through intensified feeding program

5 Participants to these seminar workshops are the Central Office Regional Office and Division Office personnel. The division participants will depend upon the region. The region will select the pilot divisions which warrant the implementation of the priority food production. For example if DECS Region IV selects the divisions of Laguna Quezon Batangas and Rizal for the corresponding priority projects the following is the breakdown of participants

CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBLE CONTESTANTS The contest is nationwide to all public elementary and secondary schools. Participating school is entitled to only one entry containing the following information at the back: Name of pupil / student, grade or year level, teacher, principal and school.

CONTEST CATEGORIES

There are two (2) contest categories:

- Elementary for Grades IV to VI pupils
- Secondary for 1st year to 4th year students

There are three (3) levels of competition: Division level, Regional level and National level. All first prize winning posters at the Division level shall be qualified to compete at the Regional Competition and all first prize winning posters at the Regional level shall compete at the National Competition.

MATERIALS AND MEDIUM

Illustration board measuring 18 x 24 inches shall be used. For both categories, any of the following may be used: crayons, craypass, pastel, color water color, pencil or charcoal.
