MONITORING AND FACILITATING VISITS IN THE REGIONS

1 Pursuant to the objectives of the Department of Education Culture and Sports Reading Education Training Program (RETP) Regional Conduct per DECS Memorandum No 134 s 2000 the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Staff Development Division Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS) will conduct the Monitoring and Facilitating Visits to the Regional RETP Batch 2

2 The Monitoring and Facilitating Visits will be conducted in sixteen (16) regions on May 9-24 2000 Training teams composed of Reading Specialists the British Resource Persons and the NEAP SDD-CO trainers are assigned to specific regions as listed in the enclosure and will remain in the training venue for five (5) days

3 The objectives of the team visits are as follows

- a Monitor the implementation of RETP Batch 2 particularly the application of the Reading Proficiency with concentration on PIRLS
- b Conduct the Pre-Test and Post Test on Reading Comprehension and Proficiency for trainees in sixteen regions
- c Assist as facilitators/trainers in the reading proficiency and the USENTER sessions
- d Distribute the USENTER Teacher's Handbook and
- e Accompany and tandem with the British Reading specialists – Mr Andrew Williams and Mr Sean Power in assigned regions

4 The said visits shall likewise monitor the application of the Progress for International Reading Proficiency Literacy Study (PIRLS) strategy of the four levels of questioning for Grade IV pupils

5 Travel expenses per diem and extra essentials of NEAP Central Office and the regional specialists shall be charged against the Training and Development Funds of SDD-HRDS subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations Travel expenses of the British Council lecturers Mr Andrew Williams and Mr Sean Power shall be shouldered by the British Council of Manila
