FIRST WORLD TELE-EDUCATION SYMPOSIUM FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

- The Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) will be conducting the "First World Tele-Education Symposium for Developing Countries" in Manaus Brazil on June 26-29 2000
- This symposium, which is designed specially for developing countries, will be a major event in that participants will have the opportunity to meet with experts in the fields of education/training and telecommunications, to learn from each other's experiences and to determine strategies for initiating and/or extending tele-education applications in their respective countries
- The objectives of the symposium are the following 3
 - а raise awareness of the potential of tele-education and the need for telecommunication and education agencies to work together in order to implement tele-education services for the benefit of the country's Inhabitants
 - b analyse the tele-education technologies and services that are currently available and/or that will be available in the near future both by sectors of society and by geographical region,
 - analyse the practical applications of tele-education, training C vocational training, formal education and
 - d exchange experiences on methodological aspects of tele-education both in its own right and as a supplement to traditional education methods
