## ANNOUNCING THE PHILIPPINE NORMAL UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL **CONFERENCE ON TEACHER EDUCATION**

- To Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals
- To usher in its centennial year of leadership and excellence in teacher education, the Philippine Normal University (PNU) is sponsoring the International Conference on Teacher Education (ICTE 2001) on January 9-11 2001 at the Manila Hotel on One Rizal Park, 1099 Manila
- The three-day conference with the theme "Teacher Education Directions, Development and Delivery" aims to serve as a forum to
  - make an initial inventory of the ongoing preparations to reinvent teacher education in the changed context of the new century,
  - b discourse on the promises and risks along philosophical, curricular pedagogical and organizational shifts taking shape in teacher education institutions
  - identify and broaden the spectrum of delivery system and strategies C available to make teacher education work, and
  - d facilitate national as well as international networking of teacher education institutions
- ICTE 2001 is open to public and private school officials and teachers under DECS, school/college/university administrators deans and faculty of education as well as researchers, and graduate students of education and attled fleids, here and overseas.
- The conference fee for local participants is Five Thousand Pesos (P5 000 00) and Two Hundred US dollars (\$200 00) for international participants to cover the cost of attendance in all sessions, snacks, lunch conference proceedings and cultural presentation Early registration at PNU is scheduled from November 15 to December 15 2000
- Participants from public schools will be allowed to attend the conference on official time only They may utilize funds from the Local School Board or from other private sources but not DECS funds. Those coming from the private schools shall make proper arrangements with their respective schools
