PROJECT LIGHTEN UPI ADOLESCENT HEALTH SCHOOL PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

1. Project Lighten Up! Adolescent Health School Program, a joint undertaking of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), Procter and Gamble Philippines (P & G), and the Foundation for Adolescent Development (FAD) is now on its 4<sup>th</sup> year of implementation.
2. The project aims to :
  - a. build self-esteem among adolescent students by developing the proper hygiene regimen and the right social skills; and
  - b. promote partnership between the school and the home through the cooperative efforts of the school administrators, teachers and parents.
3. In accordance with the project design, school visits for SY 2000-2001 shall be conducted by the Project Team representatives from DECS and P & G. During these visits, lectures will be conducted among students and sample kits will be distributed.
4. As in the past, the Regional Population Education (POPED) Coordinators, in collaboration with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), shall assist the Project Teams in this activity. They shall determine the schedule of visits cooperatively. Expenses of DECS personnel shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Full cooperation of all concerned is enjoined and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
