2000 NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

1. In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month", the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall join all the other departments and instrumentalities of the national government in celebrating the 11th National Statistics Month (NSM) this October under the auspices of the National Statistics Coordination Board (NSCB). The overall theme is "Empowering Filipino Women Through Gender Statistics".

2. The observance of this event is primarily aimed at inculcating greater public awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society. Relative to this, the NSCB has issued Memorandum Circular No. 01-2000 enjoining all government agencies, both at the national and subnational levels, to actively participate in and support this undertaking.

3. In this connection, it is requested that DECS Regions I, V, VI, VIII, IX, XI, XII and CAR coordinate with the Regional Statistical Coordination Committees (RSCCs) thru the NSCB Regional Units (RUs) while the other DECS regions are requested to coordinate with RSCCs headed by either the NEDA Regional Director (RSCC Chairperson) or the National Statistics Office (NSO) Regional Administrator (RSCC Co-Chairperson) for the NSM activities in the regions. The DECS regional activities during the month-long celebration to be included in the NSM Calendar of Activities should be submitted to the Office of Planning Service, DECS, UL Complex, Pasig City, or direct to the 11th NSM Secretariat (address indicated in the attached NSCB Form (1) on or before July 31, 2000 using the enclosed suggested format.

4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
