ROLL-OUT PLAN FOR THE FEDERATION OF PTAs FOUNDATION, INC.

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in collaboration with the National Federation of PTAs Foundation, Inc. (NFPTA), announces the holding of the regionwide seminar series for PTA federations in the provincial and city divisions. Carrying the theme "Parents and Teachers: Building Friendships, Building Bridges" (Towards Home-School Collaboration), the series seeks to strengthen education partnership between the home and the school and to pave the way to enable the division PTA federations to avail themselves of the NFPTA's national and international network and services.
2. Participants at the seminar series shall be the following, coming from each city and provincial division: four (4) PTA federation officers, two (2) supervisors, three (3) leader school administrators or teachers, one assistant schools superintendent, and two (2) alumni of the Master of Arts in Values Education of the University of Asia and the Pacific. Each regional seminar is expected to have some 80-100 participants.
3. The roll-out program, together with the suggested schedule for the 16 regions, is enclosed. This undertaking shall be under the Office of the Regional Director.
4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover seminar materials, lodging and food. Participation to this seminar shall be on official time only. Arrangements with reference to registration fee and other expenses incidental to participation in the congress may be made with local school board funds, etc.
5. In view of the educational importance of this enterprise to the full realization of quality education through home-school partnership, this Office strongly encourages full support from the regional and division offices.
