**EVALUATION RECALL AND STRATEGIC PLANNING
OF NEAP FELLOWS**

To: Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Staff Development Division, HRDS will conduct a three-day live-out NEAP Fellows' Evaluation Recall Strategic Planning Conference at the Waterfront Hotel, Lahug, Cebu City on August 8-10, 2000.
2. The three-day conference aims to:
 - a. monitor the extent of school improvement activities undertaken by NEAP fellows and evaluate the outcomes and impact of such efforts;
 - b. generate options and opportunities to develop further and continually enhance school administrators' management and leadership competencies in preparation for decentralization;
 - c. formulate strategic plans to respond to identified administrative and instructional issues and problems; and
 - d. organize nationwide networks of NEAP fellows and trainers for the establishment of the teachers' instructional support system.
3. Participants to this conference are the NEAP Regular Fellows: the elementary and secondary school principals, district and division supervisors who are graduates of the series of Advanced Management Development Program (AMDP) and Reorientation Program for District and Division Supervisors (RPDS) held in NEAP, Teachers Camp, Baguio City from 1991 to 1994. The training managers and facilitators/trainers who managed the abovementioned training programs are also invited to attend, the list of which is enclosed.
4. Carrying the theme "Decentralizing Training and Development: The NEAP Fellows' Challenge in the New Millennium", the conference will feature special inputs on the theme. Major output of the conference would be school/district/subject-specific strategic plans (MaPPs).

5. Registration and opening program are scheduled in the morning of August 8. Registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) shall be charged each participant to defray cost of food (2 snacks, buffet lunch and dinner daily, conference materials, incentives of resource speakers and management staff, rental of conference facilities and other incidental expenses. Lodging can be arranged at ECOTECH, BSP, YMCA, Applied Nutrition Center and other available venues. Participants are requested to make arrangements for their stay. The registration fee, transportation expenses to and from Cebu City, including allowances and per diems one day before and after the conference shall be charged to local funds. All expenses in connection with this conference shall be subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
