PHILIPPINE HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION (PHEA) BIENNIAL SEMINAR-
WORKSHOP IN HOME ECONOMICS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will hold a three-day Biennial Seminar-Workshop in Home Economics on October 4-6, 2000 at the Heroes Hall, Laoag City with the theme "Expanded Role of Home Economics in the New Millennium".
2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are:
 - a. to heighten an awareness of the expanding roles of Home Economics in
 1. developing human resources;
 2. improving living conditions and fostering human rights; and
 3. advocacy for families and households; and
 - b. develop classroom delivery strategies for these expanding roles.
3. Participants to the seminar-workshop are regional, division, and district supervisors, school heads, department heads and instructors/teachers who supervise/teach Home Economics and the other components of HELE (EPP) and THE, deans, heads and chiefs of Home Economics (elementary, secondary and tertiary levels) and home economists in other allied fields. Attendance of participants from public schools is on official time only.
4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) will be charged each participant to defray cost of supplies and materials and other seminar expenses such as kits, handouts, snacks and lunch and lodging. Registration fee and other expenses incidental to their attendance shall be sourced from private funds, not DECS funds. Participants from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
