42ND ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF CMLI JUNIOR MEMBERS
AND TEACHER ADVISERS

1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI) in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), will be conducting the 42nd Annual National Convention of CMLI Junior Members and Teacher Advisers with the theme "The Family as an Advocate in Upholding the Rights of the Children", on October 23-28, 2000 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. The major highlights of this six-day conference include several workshops/ commission discussions and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training and values formation, interpersonal relations and communications, Literary Musical (LITMUS), symposium, Talent Variety Show (TVS), workshops, and Youth Congress.
3. Other competitions, such as junk sculpture making contest, photojournalism contest, think-a-link contest, on-the-spot poster making contest, short story writing contest (English/Filipino) and poem writing contest (English/Filipino); a sportsfest and socials will be conducted. There will also be an election for the Junior Council, a Quiz Bowl and Debate finals. These activities aim to educate the young thereby increasing their awareness of certain socio-economic developments in the community and the environment. Enclosed are the guidelines and schedule of activities.
4. The conference fee is Four Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (P4,300.00) per delegate inclusive of board and lodging, conference materials, tour expenses, and other training expenses. Participants coming from public schools are allowed to attend on official time only. Those coming from private institutions may make arrangements with their administrators.
