**SEMINAR FOR SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS**

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

1. The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (SCAAP), in cooperation with the DECS Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), will conduct a Seminar for Science Club Advisers from September 27 to October 1, 2000 at the DECS ECOTECH Learning Center, Lahug, Cebu City as part of the National Science Club Month (NSCM) celebration.

2. With its theme "Science Leaders' Quest for Culture of Excellence", the seminar is designed to meet the needs and re-invent the perspective of science leaders in understanding the basic concepts in science focused on content, strategies and culture of excellence to uplift science education in the new millennium. It aims to train the participants on how to enhance the teaching of various aspects of science, upgrade knowledge on curricular content, higher order thinking skills, multi-intelligence in teaching and constructivist theory, among others.

3. Participants to this seminar are Science leaders, Science club advisers, Science teachers, coordinators, and district and division supervisors. A registration fee of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (P2,900.00) shall be charged each participant. A division that could send fifteen (15) participants is entitled to a free registration of one (1) supervisor. Arrangements should be made for the substitution of teachers who will attend this seminar so that no classes will be disrupted. Participants may seek the assistance of the local school board or various organizations to ensure maximum participation. The registration will cover expenses for accommodation, meals, educational tour, certificates and other miscellaneous expenses. Enclosed is the schedule of activities.
