## CONFERENCE ON THE FILIPINO-AMERICAN WAR

To: Bureau/Service/Center Directors Regional Directors School Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The National Historical Institute (NHI), a cultural agency under the administrative supervision of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), will hold the National Conference on the Filipino-American War on November 15-17, 2000 at the Manila Hotel, Roxas Blvd., Manila.
- 2. The national conference has the following objectives:
  - a. to pay tribute to the heroism and patriotism of the Filipino freedom fighters;
  - to provide new insights into the conditions of the era and correlate them to events happening today;
  - to pose questions which will motivate scholars to seek out new data which will help to resolve controversial issues relating to the events;
  - d. to build a scholarly body of work relating to the Filipino-American War, and
  - to instill in us an abiding love and appreciation of our national and local heroes whose sacrifices and martyrdom have given us the freedom we enjoy today.
- 3. Participants in this national conference are teachers in History, Social Studies and related subjects and department heads interested in strengthening the teaching of Philippine History and allied courses. Arrangements for substitutions of classes of teachers who are attending should be made so there will be no disruption of classes.
- 4. Participation slots are subject to first-come, first-served basis. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for registration, funch, snacks (am/pm), conference kits and handouts. However, teachers and faculty members will be given 10% discount of the registration fee, hence, they will only pay One Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Pesos (P1,350.00) upon presentation of any valid IDs to the Secretariat. Breakfast and dinner will be at the expense of the participants. Accommodations for out-of-town participants may be recommended by the National Historical Institute at affordable hotels/lodging houses near the conference venue. The cost will be shouldered by the participants.
- Participants from government institutions shall be allowed to attend on official time only.
   Those from private sectors are encouraged to obtain funding or subsidy from their respective academic institutions.
