## FOURTH NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS ADMINISTRATORS AND PRINCIPALS

To: **Bureau Directors** Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents Private Secondary Schools Principals

- The Private Secondary Schools Administrators Association of the Philippines (PRISSAAP), in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, announces the holding of the "Fourth National Assembly of Private Secondary Schools Administrators and Principals" to be held at the Auditorium of the De La Salle Lipa, Lipa City on October 16-18, 2000.
- 2. The assembly aims to:
  - a. bring together the administrators and principals of the private secondary schools in an assembly for sharing the insights for professional enrichment;
  - b. gain insights from the different topics of the assembly and the workshops to enhance administrative and instructional leadership capabilities;
  - c. foster better networking and linkaging among principals and administrators of private secondary schools; and
  - d. enable participants to likewise share learning experiences with others in their respective regions and localities through echo assemblies and workshops to be organized by the regional chapters.
- A seminar fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00) inclusive of board and lodging, kits and handouts for the assembly shall be charged for those who register on or before September 15, and Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P3,800.00) for those who register after September 15, 2000.
