NATIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS FOR THE PHILIPPINE  
SPORTS TALENT IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM (PSTIP)

To: Undersecretaries  
Assistant Secretaries  
Bureau Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) as co-implementors of the Philippine Sports Talent Identification Program (PSTIP), shall conduct the National Training of Trainers for the Philippine Sports Talent Identification Program. This is in line with the efforts to institutionalize the program of identifying potential sports talents among pupils aged 8-12 years old who can be tapped for higher levels of athletic training.

The training shall be conducted in two (2) phases as follows:

- a. Luzon Group – will be held on September 13-15, 2000 at the Philsports Arena (formerly ULTRA), Pasig City; and
- b. Visayas & Mindanao Group – will be held on October 11-13, 2000 at the Abellana High School, Cebu City.

2. There shall be a DECS Task Force which shall plan, implement, monitor, and evaluate the program; and a DECS Working Group which shall assist in the conduct of the national training. The composition of the DECS Task Force and Working Group for the PSTIP is indicated in the enclosure.

3. Participants to the training are one (1) regional P.E. supervisor per region and one (1) division P.E. supervisor/coordinator/elementary P.E. teacher each from all the divisions, who are not more than 45 years old, and are physically fit. Preference is given to those who have undergone the "Training on the Enhancement of the Teaching of Physical Fitness" conducted by DECS at Teachers Camp, Baguio City last December 2-8, 1999.

4. Participants must bring with them appropriate attire for the training such as t-shirts, shorts, jogging pants, and rubber shoes.

5. Transportation expenses (bus and boat fares only), board and lodging of all participants, trainers, and management team, and other expenses incidental to the training shall be borne by the PSC.

6. Registration of participants shall start at 9:00 a.m. on September 12 and October 10, 2000 for the Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao groups, respectively.
