DECS MEMORANDUM 397, 2000

BREAKING BARRIERS, BUILDING PEACE AND LOVE FOR COUNTRY

To: Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents

- The MUSEO PAMBATA, in partnership with DECS, is embarking on a project for selected high school students, teachers and principals from nine (9) areas of the Philippines, a total of 360 students and 180 principals/teachers. This project is called "Breaking Barriers, Building Peace and Love for Country".
- The project includes the following components:
 - A travelling exhibit using the traditional arts and crafts as unifying theme, illustrating unity in diversity. This hands-on interactive exhibit is titled "Iba't Ibang Kamay, Iisang Buhay....Pilipino!"
 - b. A workshop of two and a half (2 1/2) days(live-out) on the theme "Breaking Barriers, Building Peace and Love for Country," with the following topics:
 - My Identity;
 - Situation of Children Today;
 - 3. Perceptions of Being Filipino;
 - Our Collective Talents as a Nation; and
 - 5. Creating the Future
- Each workshop will have two (2) high school students and one (1) principal or teacher from 20 high schools by region, or a total of 40 students and 20 adults. The regional director is requested to identify the 20 schools, the participants and a convenient venue (a school or training site which can accommodate 60 to 70 persons).

 - transportation of participants to and from site; and Ç.
 - accommodation of six (6) facilitators in the venue or in a nearby school for đ. the duration of the workshop.
