SEARCH FOR THE OUTSTANDING SCIENCE CLUBS AND SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS OF THE PHILIPPINES

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28 declaring September as the National Science Club Month (NSCM) and authorizing the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) to implement plans and activities in celebration thereof, the Department, through the DECS Center for Students and Co-Cumcular Affairs (CSCA), the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. and the Science Club Advisers' Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), is organizing a Search for the Outstanding Science Clubs and Science Club Advisers of the Philippines.
- 2. The Search aims to achieve the following:
 - a. Promote science consciousness and public understanding of science, technology and environment in the grassroots level;
 - Highlight the importance of co-curricular organizations in schools and their significant contributions in the community through relevant programs, projects and activities; and
 - Recognize exemplary science clubs and science clubs advisers in the elementary and secondary levels throughout the country.
- 3. The Search is open to all elementary and secondary science clubs affiliated with the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, (PSYSC), Inc. and science club advisers duly registered with the Science Club Advisers' Association of the Philippines (SCAAP).
- The enclosed mechanics and timetable of activities shall guide the implementation of the Search.

- 5. All DECS officials are enjoined to actively support the activity. The division and regional offices shall provide certificates and other incentives for all ntries and coordinators of the Search. Incidental expenses of the Division or Regional Selection Committees shall be charged against their respective local funds.
- 6. A consolidated report indicating the list of all winning science clubs in the division level and regional level per category, including the name of the originating schools, addresses, name of the School Principal and Science Club President shall be submitted by the DECS regional office to the National Search Committee c/o:

SEARCH FOR THE OUTSTANDING SCIENCE CLUBS AND SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS OF THE PHILIPPINES

The Search for the Outstanding Science Clubs and Science Cub Advisers of the Philippines is a nationwide search that aims to recognize exemplary and outstanding science clubs in the country. These are the science clubs that made significant contributions to the advancement of science education, youth science leadership and community service through the conduct of and participation in science club, and science and science and technology-related activities.

As we celebrate the National Science Club Month every September of the year, it is but appropriate to give due recognition to these science clubs so they may serve as model and inspiration for the science clubbing movement.

MECHANICS

- 1. The Search for the Outstanding Science Clubs and Science Club Advisers of the Philippines has two categories; namely, elementary and secondary.
- The Search is open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools with duly
 organized science clubs and affiliated with the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs,
 (PSYSC) Inc. on or before September 30, 2000, and their advisers duly registered with the
 Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) on or before October 30,
 2000.
- Entry forms will be available at the DECS Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs, PSYSC National Office, SCAAP National Office and DECS Regional and Division Offices. The same will also be sent directly to current PSYSC-affiliated science clubs and to members of the SCAAP.
- The science club and the science club adviser must submit the following requirements on or before October 13, 2000:
 - a. Duly accomplished Official Entry Form
 - b. Complete list of officers and adviser
 - Club Constitution and By-Laws, Organizational Structure, Logo/Seal, and Club Handbooks (if applicable)
 - d. List of projects and activities conducted from June 1999 September 2000 with --
 - a brief description of the project/activity
 - 2. venue or duration of the project/activity
 - 3. participants, audience, or beneficiaries
 - 4. scope of the activity
 - 5. cooperating agencies

- other supporting documents which may include any of the following: photographs, video coverage, newsletters/newspapers (or school paper) clippings, output / research papers, and certifications
- List of science activities/projects participated in by the club or its members, officers, and/or advisers in the national, regional, division, and community level from June 1999 – September 2000 with –
 - 1. brief description of activity/project
 - level of participation
 - photocopy of the certificates/certifications received
- f. List of Awards/Citations received by the club and/or its advisers/officers while doing activities related to the club from June 1999 – September 2000 with –
 - 1. brief description of award/citation
 - 2. agency/organization giving the award
 - 3. photocopy of certificate/plaque (where possible) or certification
- g. Science Club Adviser's Profile, which should include -
 - 1. Contributions/Innovations to the science club
 - 2. Citations/Awards received in connection with role as Science Club Adviser
 - 3. Length of service as a science club adviser
 - 4. Designation letter as science club adviser given by the School Principal
 - List of activities undertaken with the science club and participation in national, regional, division, district and school level
- h. Other documents which the club may deem meritorious for evaluation.
- 5. The following criteria for judging shall be employed:

- 6. The following shall be adopted in the selection and judging of entries:
 - a. Selection shall follow a three-level process; namely, Division, Regional and National.
 - b. All interested science clubs, with their respective science club advisers, shall submit their application and other documents direct to the DECS Division Office concerned. A selection committee composed of the Division Superintendent and/or the Division Science Supervisor/s or Coordinator/s and two others from the Division Promotional Staff shall evaluate the entries and select one winner each per category.
 - c. It shall be understood that in the course of the three-level selection and judging process, the choice of the winning science club by the respective selection committees in the division, regional and national levels carries with it the choice of the science club's adviser as winner in the parallel search for the outstanding science club adviser.
 - d. The committee shall transmit the same, depending on the search category, to th DECS Regional Office c/o the respective DECS Regional Science Supervisor for elementary and secondary.
 - e. The two division winners shall be qualified to compete in the Regional Search in their respective category as regional level finalists. A Regional Selection Committee per category, composed of the Regional Director, Chief of the Elementary or Secondary Education Division, as the case maybe, Regional Science Supervisor of the elementary or secondary, as the case maybe, including two representatives from the private sector, shall be organized to select one winner from each category in th Regional Search.
 - f. The two regional winners shall be eligible to compete in the National Search in their respective category as national level finalists. All documents shall be forwarded to the DECS Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), Ground Floor, Mabini Building, DECS Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.

- g. The National Selection Committee shall review all national level finalists. It shall b composed of representatives from the DECS-CSCA, PSYSC, and SCAAP, including three (3) individuals nominated for their involvement in science clubbing and science education.
- h. The decision of the Selection Committee is final and unappealable.
- 7. The following prizes await the winners:
