## ANNOUNCING THE SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION FOR CY 2001

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI), announces the Undergraduate Science and Technology Scholarship for the CY 2001. The scholarship examination will be administered in one hundred sixteen (116) test centers throughout the country on November 12, 2000.
- 2. Students qualified to take the scholarship examination are graduating students of SY 2000-2001 or high school graduates who have not yet earned any units in any post secondary or undergraduate course and wish to enter college in SY 2001-2002. They must belong to the upper 5% of the graduating class, in good health and must have a good moral character. Applicants must not have taken previous DOST-SEI undergraduate scholarship examination. Requirements must be duly certified by concerned authorities.
- 3. Applications must be filed on or before September 28, 2000 for processing at the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), Third Floor, PTRI Bldg., Bicutan, Taguig, Metro Manila or at the DOST Regional Offices and Provincial Science and Technology Centers nearest the applicants' schools or home addresses. Application forms are available at the aforementioned offices/centers or from DECS Regional Offices, Offices of the Municipal Mayors and Branches of the Land Bank of the Philippines.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
