Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

- 1. The Association of Social Science Educators, Researchers and Trainors, (ASSERT, Inc.) will conduct its national conference on the theme "Enhancing Social Studies Curriculum and Teaching Strategies Through Research and Module Preparation", on October 18-20, 2000 at the Punta Villa Training Center, Arevalo, Iloilo city.
- 2. The objectives of the conference are to:
  - a. update the teachers on current and relevant social studies information;
  - help them generate local social studies information and historical literatures through research.
- 3. The research techniques and workshop can also help the teachers develop modules and syllabi which can improve their social studies curriculum. Enclosed is the Program of Activities.
- 4. Participants to this conference are secondary and elementary schools teachers who are involved with the teaching and research of social studies courses. Public school participants are allowed to attend on official time only. Those coming from the private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions. Teachers who will attend should make arrangements for substitutes for their classes.
- 5. A registration fee of One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P1,200.00) will be charged each participant to cover the costs of conference kits, lunch and snacks. The participants will be housed at the Punta Villa Training Center at very minimum cost per head. The cost of an optional educational tour is not included in the registration.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
