## 2000 NATIONAL DEAF AWARENESS WEEK

Heads of Private Special Schools/Centers

- Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 829 dated November 8, 1991, the 2000 National Deaf Awareness Week will be observed on November 12-18. The theme of the celebration is "Towards the Making of Progressive Deaf Filipinos".
- All schools with Special Education (SPED) programs for the deaf are enjoined to undertake and/or participate in the following activities:
  - disseminate information on the irreparable loss of hearing through symposia;
  - conduct free ear examination in coordination with medical or professional organizations for the deaf;
  - visit regular and special schools with classes for the deaf for dialogue on trends and practices in early intervention and other programs;
  - recognize and give awards to the outstanding teachers of the deaf and to d. outstanding deaf students; and
  - hold exhibits, storytelling/art contests and camps.
- Heads of aforementioned schools are likewise encouraged to invite other agencies and 3. organizations providing services to the deaf to join the celebration.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
