THIRD NATIONAL CONGRESS OF PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS

To: **Bureau Directors** Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents

- The Philippine Association of Public Secondary School Administrators (PAPSSA), in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will hold its Third National Congress on November 20-23, 2000 at the Grand Men Seng Hotel, Magallanes-Anda Sts., Davao City. The theme of the congress is "From Teacher to Curriculum: What Competencies are Most Worth?"
- The congress looks at the high school curriculum for secondary education with the aim of arriving at a framework for aims, objectives, content, methodology and evaluation. The congress also aims to apprise the public school administrators of the current policies, programs and projects affecting secondary education, synthesize feedbacks from the field as regards the implementation of education programs and thrusts, and develop a more directed and focused commitment as educational managers in the present decade.
- Participants to this congress are principals/assistant principals/head teachers/master teachers/TICs of public national general and comprehensive secondary schools, chiefs or assistant chiefs of Secondary Education Division, supervisors, superintendents and assistant superintendents in charge of secondary education.
- A registration fee of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P4,800.00) shall be charged each participant and committee members to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials and kits. This and other incidental expenses may be sourced from local school board and/or other sources except DECS funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Members of the different committees shall be considered participants and shall pay the registration fee and are authorized to travel two days before the congress. First congress meal will be dinner of November 20, and the last, dinner of November 23.
