2000-2001 "VOICE OF OUR YOUTH (VOY)" NATIONAL IMPROMPTU SPEAKING CONTEST

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents Private Secondary Schools Principals

- 1. The Allied Banking Corporation, the nine (9) Rotary Districts nationwide and the Rotary Club of Bagumbayan-Manila, with the support and cooperation of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will conduct the 2000-2001 "Voice of our Youth" National Impromptu Speaking Contest.
- The VOY is open to all Filipino high school students, 15-18 years old (by January 1, 2001) from private and public schools nationwide.
- 3. The contest aims to develop the Filipino youth towards world-class proficiency in English, in furtherance of universal understanding and cooperation. Specifically, the contest aims to help develop the Filipino students' ability to think constructively and to articulate their thoughts clearly and effectively in English.  - b. District Level (Semi-Final Round); and





It is intended to inspire the fillipino youth to attain world-class proficiency in English communication, in a private or profice of universal understanding and cooperation.

COMPETITION LIVELS

Club Level Competition (Elimination Round)

- to be participated in by students from schools within the territory of a Rotary Club
- to be managed by the various Rotary Clubs within each Rotary District; each club to select one official representative to the District Level Competition
- to be held not later than November 25, 2000

District Level Competition (Semi-final Round)

- to be proceipated in by the official entries of the various Rotary Clubs within each Rotary District
- to be managed by each of the 10 Rotary Districts; each district to select two official representatives to the National Level Competition
- to be held not later than January 12, 2001

Note:

Them should be at least 15 contestants in each District Level Competits a. Otherwise, the district level minners of the Rotary District concerned will not qualify to participate in the National Level Competition

National Level Competition (Grand Finals)

- n to be participated in by the 20 district level winners
- to be managed by the National Secretariat, to select the National Champion and one runner-up
- to be held on February 16, 2001, 2:00 pm, at the Philamlife Auditorium, Unived Nations Avenue, Ermita, Manilla

CONTEST BUTTER & CUIDELINES

[Applicable to-club, district and national level competition

- A common topic will be the subject of the contestants' speeches in each competition. The topics to be chosen will be within the competence of an average high school student. These shall be respectively prepared by the Rotary Clubs/Districts and the National Secretariat.
- Shortly before the start of each competition, the contestants will be asked to draw a number to determine their speaking sequence and thereafter, will be isolated in a place outside hearing distance of the proceedings.
- The contestants will be individually informed of the chosen topic
 after every five minutes, in accordance with their speaking sequence.
 They will be given 15 minutes to prepare. The contestants may write
 notes in preparing their speeches but no notes or codes will be
 allowed on stage.
- Each contestant's speech should not be less than four minutes but not more than five minutes. A signal will be given on the fourth minute to guide the contestants. Points may be lost if a contestant falls below or exceeds the time requirement.
- 5. The contestants will be judged according to the following criteria:
 - substance of speech;
 - relevance and originality of ideas presented:
 - effective use of the English language; and
 - spontanetty and overall effectiveness of delivery.

The contest is not a debating, elocution, nor an acting competition. Thus, trelevant humor or sarcasm, use of dramatics, or unnecessary gestures should be avoided by the contestants.

- The decision of the Board of Judges of the Club, District, and National Level Competitions shall be final and cannot be appealed.
- 7. Any queries or matters of concern that may be raised regarding the interpretation of the contest rules and guidelines in the conduct of the Club, district, and National Level Competitions shall be respectively decided on by the Club Presidents, District Governors and National Secretariat, whose decision will be final.
- The contest sponsors reserve the right to release to media materials on contest results and proceedings.

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
