## **CURRICULUM SCOPE AND SEQUENCE WORKSHOP**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. After a series of consultative conferences where views and perceptions of various stakeholders were surfaced, the Curriculum Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) shall conduct a workshop on scope and sequence of Basic Education. Aforesaid activity shall be conducted at the Princess Travellers Inn, Guadalupe Nuevo, Makati City on November 6-10, 2000.

- 2. The workshop aims to develop the:
  - a. scope and sequence for Grades 1-10; and
  - b. learning competencies for Grade VII of the Twenty-First Century Secondary Education Curriculum (T-SEC).
- 3. Participants to this workshop will be eighty nine (89) curriculum writers, subject specialists, consultants/resource persons, administrative and support staff from the BSE, BEE, Central Office (CO) and selected regions of the country.
- 4. Travelling expenses, honoraria, overtime pay, board and lodging and other incidental fees for the CO, BSE, BEE personnel, regional writers and consultants/resource persons shall be charged against BSE (Curriculum Revision Program) funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
