NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE FILIPINO TEACHER

The Division of Curriculum and Instruction of the University of the Philippines College of Education will hold a National Conference on the Filipino Teacher with the theme "Shaping the Future of Education Through Research on the Filipino Teacher on February 1-3, 2001 at the University of the Philippines-Institute of Science and Mathematics Education Development (UP-ISMED), University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.

The conference aims to:

- review and promote search on the Filipino teacher in education, history, anthropology, psychology, sociology, language, literature, gender studies, Asian studies, community development, music, art studies and related fields:
- promote exchange of ideas among scholars and practitioners who have written about the Filipino teacher;
- recognize the contributions of the Filipino teacher to the country; and C.
- đ. draw implications for the preparation of teachers in all contexts.
- The participants to this conference are public and private elementary/secondary school teachers, teachers in higher education, teachers in various circumstances including parateachers and teacher educators. Teachers who will attend should make arrangements for substitutes for their classes.
- The conference fee is Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P2,250.00) for early birds and Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) after November 16 and Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for paper readers/workshop presentors on or before November 16 to cover lunch, snacks and conference kit.
