FIRST SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SPORTS PSYCHOLOGY AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

- 1. The Association of Government Psychologists of the Philippines, Inc. (AGPPI) and the Association of Sports Psychologists and Physical Educators of the Philippines (ASPPEP), in cooperation with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC), will conduct the First Seminar-Workshop on Sports Psychology and Physical Education on December 12-13, 2000 at the Pag-asa Hall, National Center for Mental Health, Mandaluyong City.
- The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
