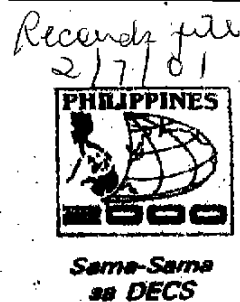

**PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF CHEMISTRY TEACHERS (PACT)  
2001 NATIONAL CONVENTION**

1. The Philippine Association of Chemistry Teachers (PACT) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will hold its Annual National Convention on February 23-24, 2001 at the CAS Little Theater Hall, College of Arts and Sciences, University of the Philippines-Manila, Padre Faura, Manila with the theme "Chemistry Education in a Global Society".
2. The convention aims to equip chemistry teachers and, in turn, their students with the necessary knowledge and skills based on the new developments/trend in chemistry education taking place around the globe.
3. Participants in this activity are chemistry teachers in the secondary and tertiary levels from both public and private schools. Attendance of public school teachers is on official time only. Substitutes shall be assigned to take over the loads of the teachers involved in the said activity. Those from the private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions or sponsoring agencies.
4. Convention fees are One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) and One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P1,200.00) for pre-registered members and non-members, respectively. However, on-site registration shall be One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P1,200.00) for members and One Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (P1,400.00) for non-members and Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P750.00) for students. Deadline for pre-registration is February 1, 2001. Registration on the day of the convention shall start at 7:00 a.m.
5. Teachers who are interested to present papers or conduct workshop must submit a one-page abstract for a three-hour presentation. This must include list of materials and equipment. Deadline for submission shall be February 1, 2001 to Prof. Teresita F.
