- 2. Please type the abstract using Times New Roman font size 12, single-spaced with one-inch top/bottom and left/right margins and single blank line between paragraphs:
- 3. If sent by email, please send the file as an MS Word attachment.
- 4. Do not use footnotes, headers or footers;
- 5. Abstracts should clearly describe the intended presentation (paper, case study, courseware, etc.)
- 6. Abstracts should be factual without tables, charts, or graph;
