**2001 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON HEARING IMPAIRMENT,
EDUCATIONAL AUDIOLOGY AND MENTAL RETARDATION**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Chairman, CHED

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, Culture and Sports in coordination with Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM) and Better Hearing Philippines, Inc. is sponsoring training programs in the following areas for Summer 2001 at the designated institutions or venues:

A. Hearing Impairment

- Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired, (Second Batch), Eulogio "Amang" Rodriguez Institute of Science and Technology (EARIST), Nagtahan, Manila, April 16 - May 9, 2001;
- Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired, (New Batch): Visayas Area, Cebu State University, Cebu City: April 2 - 27, 2001;
- Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired, (New Batch): Mindanao Area, Holy Cross College, Davao City: May 2-29, 2001

B. Educational Audiology

- Short-Term Training of Teachers for the Deaf on Educational Audiology, University of Sto. Tomas, Espana, Manila, May 7-11, 2001

C. Mental Retardation

- Live-In Training-Workshop for Teachers of Children with Mental Retardation: Mindanao Area, RELC-Region XI, E. Quirino Avenue, Davao City, May 2-9, 2001
- Live-In Training-Workshop for Teachers of Children with Mental Retardation: Visayas Area, ECOTECH, Lahug, Cebu City, April 18-25, 2001

2. These programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with hearing impairment and those with mental retardation.

3. Priority participants/nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the hearing impaired and the mentally retarded (See Enclosures Nos. 1-A,B,C, 2, 3-A,B). The training for the new batch of teachers for the hearing impaired in the Luzon area has been deferred due to budgetary constraints. Applicants shall be screened by the Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 4. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is on the 2nd week of February 2001. The list of nominees shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education not later than March 15, 2001. The selected nominees shall be advised to submit all the documents listed in Enclosures Nos. 4 and 5 to the same office before the training programs begin.

4. Selected teachers who were recipients of the DECS-CBM-EARIST Summer Training Program in Summer 2000 are considered for their Second Summer Training in 2001. Their names are listed in Enclosure No. 1-A. But only those teachers who are actually providing educational services to the hearing impaired students shall be given the opportunity to continue their training.

5. Grantees under the summer training programs at EARIST, Cebu State University and Holy Cross College shall be entitled to free tuition fee and a monthly stipend of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00). Their traveling expenses to and from the venue shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies. They are advised to travel by sea or land. However, those coming from the National Capital Region, Cebu City and Davao City shall be entitled to a stipend of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) only. The trainees at the University of Sto. Tomas who come from the different regions except NCR are entitled to free training fee with an allowance of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) including traveling expenses while those from the NCR will be given One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00). Travel expenses of the trainees for the live-in workshops on mental retardation shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies.

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, Culture and Sports, DECS Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents. Expenses for the training shall be charged to their agency funds.

3. Conduct himself/herself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor to himself/herself, his/her school/agency and Christoffel Blindenmission,

4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education at the end of the training a copy of his/her action plan;

5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;

6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing impaired or mentally retarded;
7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training;
8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to Christoffel Blindenmission such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the hearing impaired or the mentally retarded for at least two (2) years after each summer training; and
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
