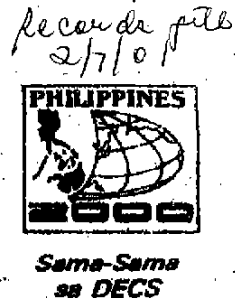

**TEACHER EDUCATION COUNCIL (TEC) NATIONAL CONSULTATION
ON THE ZONAL OUTPUTS OF THE PROTOTYPE SYLLABI
PREPARATION FOR BSEd MAJOR SUBJECTS**

1. The Teacher Education Council (TEC), in coordination with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will hold a National Consultation on the Zonal Outputs of the Prototype Syllabi Preparation for BSEd Major Subjects on February 26-28, 2001 at the Richville Mansion Hotel, EDSA, Mandaluyong City.
2. The national consultation purports to analyze/review the outputs of the prototype syllabi and determine the final sequence of courses in the major program for English, Filipino, Home Economics, Mathematics, Music and Arts, PE and Health, Science (General Science, Biology, Chemistry and Physics), Social Studies, Values Education, Agricultural Technology, Business Technology, Fisheries Technology and Industrial Technology prepared during the recently concluded zonal workshops held in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
3. Participants to the national consultation are selected teacher practitioners/specialists for the abovementioned subject areas. Chairman/senior members of the CHED Technical Panel for Humanities, Social Science and Communication (HUSOCOM), Science and Mathematics (TPSM), Agricultural Education, Business and Management Education, and Teacher Education, and TEC members from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Professional Regulation Commission (PRC), National Commission for Culture and Arts (NCCA), zonal representatives from Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao and teacher representatives for Language, Mathematics, Science and Technology and Social Studies are also participants to this national consultation.
4. Participants are requested to bring references to facilitate production of the needed outputs of the consultation.
5. Food and accommodation for the official participants will be shouldered by the Teacher Education Council. Transportation and other allowable expenses of participants from government institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Registration of participants will start at 1:00 p.m. on February 26 to give ample time for those who are coming from the province and other regions. The program

starts at exactly 8:00 a.m. of February 27. Participants are strictly encouraged to register within the time schedule to maximize time allotted for the workshop proper.
