SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON MUSIC AND MOVEMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Kodaly Society of the Philippines will hold a special one-day seminar-workshop on music for early childhood educators and primary school educators on April 23, 2001 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the U.P. College of Music, Diliman, Quezon City. The theme of the seminar is "Music and Movement for Children: the Dalcroze Method".
2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. help early childhood educators and primary school teachers develop an awareness of the importance of having music and movement activities for children; and
 - b. demonstrate some activities and techniques to teach music so that these activities become achievable for the teachers;
3. Lecturer for the seminar will be Ms. Carolyn Cheng, music consultant at Immaculate Conception Academy and pre-school music teacher at Children's Talent Education Center for ages 2-6 for the past 15 years. She is also one of the few Filipinos to be a holder of a Dalcroze License from the Longy School of Music in Cambridge, Massachusetts. The Dalcroze Method is an internationally known method that teaches music through the use of body movement, singing and creative activities.
4. A seminar fee of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) will be charged each participant covering tuition, materials, lunch and membership fee. 5. Participants from the public schools may attend on official time only. Participants from private institutions may have their own financial arrangements with their respective schools.
