**16<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL DANCE EDUCATORS CONVENTION-WORKSHOP**

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Dance Education Association of the Philippines (DEAP) is sponsoring the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Dance Educators Convention-Workshop to be held on May 21-25, 2001 at the Polytechnic University of the Philippines, as the host institution.
2. The theme of the convention is "Dance Preservation and Transformation: A Continuing Challenge to Dance Leadership in Education".
3. The objectives of the workshop are to:
  - a) discuss innovative strategies that can strengthen dance leadership in education;
  - b) analyze and discover possibilities of preserving our traditional dances in keeping with the modern times; and
  - c) instill national consciousness in the process of cultural development.
4. Participants to the workshop are physical education teachers, supervisors, administrators and other dance enthusiasts from related disciplines. Those coming from the public institutions are allowed to attend on official time only. Participants from the private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions or organizations.
5. Participants will be charged a registration fee of One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P1,800.00) to cover the honoraria for resource persons, handout materials and taped music of the dances to be taught, certificates and other expenses incident to the operation of the convention-workshop.
