  - value the importance of self expression, and creativity through the mediums of music, art and movement education.
- Participants to this seminar are public and private school supervisors, department heads, Music, Art and Physical Education teachers in the elementary and secondary levels.
- A registration fee of One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P1,750.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the operational expenses such as training materials, training manual, certificate of participation, honoraria for speakers, snacks, lunch and other expenses related to the conduct of the activity.
- Participants from the public schools are allowed to attend on official time only. Those coming from the private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions.
