DECS MEMORANDUM No. 65, s. 2001

SIGNIFICANT MATTERS FOR THE FUTURE FARMERS OF THE PHILIPPINES FUTURE AGRICULTURAL HOMEMAKERS OF THE PHILIPPINES AND FUTURE HOMEMAKERS OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Vocational Secondary School Administrators
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

- 1. Pursuant to DECS Order No. 54, s. 2000 and DECS Memorandum No. 499, s. 2000 on the revitalization and activities of the Future Farmers of the Philippines (FFP), the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FAHP), and the Future Homemakers of the Philippines (FHP) and as a result of the planning and consultative conference held last February 1-2, 2001 at the DECS Central Office, the following significant matters must be noted.
- 2. The national officers of the organizations are hereby constituted effective immediately. In as much as the activities of the said organizations are DECS-led and organized, the officers shall perform their duties and functions on official business and shall serve in their respective capacities until replaced by the National Adviser.
- 3. Member-schools are encouraged to conduct activities that strengthen values formation, develop skills, promote competitiveness and creativity, and foster environmental and social consciousness among the students. A list of valuable skills is enclosed to guide the member-schools in the conduct of their activities and in preparation for their respective Regional Work Conferences.
- 4. In order to promote excellence and quality, a strategic plan to unify FFP, FAHP and FHP into one umbrella organization to be dubbed as the Student Technologists and Entrepreneurs of the Philippines (STEP) shall be proposed and consolidated. Necessarily, a set of criteria and standards shall be formulated and issued for schools to be accepted as members, either of the FFP, FAHP or FHP, and eventually of the STEP.
- 5. Instead of a national work conference, an FFP-FAHP-FHP National Students Skills Competition shall be held next school year, where qualified competitors from the different regions shall participate, details of which shall be contained in a separate Memorandum.
- 6. The current voluntary membership fee of P20.00 shall remain in effect. The school chapter treasurer shall handle the amount pertaining to the school share while the regional share shall be remitted to the treasurer of the Regional Organization and the national share to the National Treasurer of FFP-FAHP-FHP. For this purpose, FFP-FAHP-FHP

organizations are the only duly recognized organizations in the THE subject area, and as such, no other collection shall be authorized by the DECS Regional Office in this respect. Transparency and proper accounting of the funds shall be strictly observed.

- 7. All Regional Directors, Schools Superintendents, Vocational Secondary School Administrators and Secondary School Principals are encouraged to support and cooperate in the strengthening of the FFP-FAHP-FHP organizations in their respective schools. Likewise, all Regional Coordinators are enjoined to coordinate with the regional officers and member-schools in the intensification of the FFP-FAHP-FHP programs and activities.
- 8. It is likewise desired that all post-secondary schools under CHED and TESDA constituting the Future Farmers of the Philippines Collegiate Chapter (FFPCC) elect their own set of officers and synchronize and join their activities with the FFP and FAHP.
