
1. The Classic School of Cosmetology and Splash Manufacturing Corporation in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and Commission on Higher Education (CHED) shall conduct a five-day regional Seminar-Workshop on Cosmetology for department heads and teachers in Technology and Home Economics (THE) at the following regions and host schools:

2. The seminar-workshop aims to:
 - 1.1 upgrade the teaching methodology in cosmetology;
 - 1.2 raise the awareness of teachers on the new trends in cosmetology;
 - 1.3 develop the skills in modern haircutting techniques; and
 - 1.4 develop skills in the operation of modern equipment, machine on hair, facial and skin care treatment.
3. Participants to the seminar-workshop are secondary school teachers and department heads of THE.
4. Attendance of participants from public schools is on **Official time only**.
5. Registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000) per participant includes snacks and lunch for 5 days and one mannequin with long hair and clamp to be used as model in the workshop. However, participants have the option not to purchase the mannequin. Thus, registration fee will only cost P1,750.00. Hair coloring cream, bleaching powder, oxidizing lotion, styling aid shall be provided (free) to all participants by Splash Manufacturing Corporation.
6. A Hairstyling Competition shall be conducted at the end of the seminar-workshop.

SUBJECT : Nationwide Regional Upgrading Seminar
Workshop for Cosmetology Teachers
